

VENUE

The conference will be held in the Center for Free-Electron Laser Science at the Universität Hamburg Bahrenfeld Campus.

Adress: Luruper Ch 149, Hamburg (this is the address of the side entrance which is the easiest way to access the CFEL building – number 99 on <u>this Campus Map</u>.

The venue is 5 km from the Altona station (bus-line 2) and 10 km from Hamburg Central Station (bus-line 3). You can find online bus timetables and journey planners <u>here.</u>
