The conference will be held in the Center for Free-Electron Laser Science at the Universität Hamburg Bahrenfeld Campus.

Address: Luruper Ch 149, Hamburg (this is the address of the side entrance which is the easiest way to access the CFEL building – number 99 on [this Campus Map](#)).
